Wine description

The Rosengartl, an almost forgotten single vineyard in Strass with enormous potential, which we brought back to life in 2015. The old vineyards guarantee powerful Veltliners with enormous aging potential. Probably one of the best spots to grow Grüner Veltliner in the Kamptal.

Handpicked, temperature controlled fermentation with natural yeasts at 19-22°C, extended lees contact,

Tasting notes

Spicy – exotic – rich – a first impression which changes with time and air. Cold minerality, dark pepper, a yeasty touch and dark fruit complement the aroma spectrum. The lively acidity carries the wine, long finish, enormous fruit and juicy.

About the Vineyard

The soil is a result of the dry and cold climate of the Ice Age. Due to the effect of glaciers producing a high pressure on the land, quartz, limestone, mica and clay particles were pulverised. These loess soils retain deep reservoirs of moisture and rarely suffer from dehydration. The "Ried" ROSENGARTL comprises gentle, south-facing terraces at an elevation of 250-340 meters, that are protected to the northwest by the Wechselberg. The loess terraces are draped over the gneiss bedrock and marine sediments. Wines with a harmonious combination of strength, body, characteristic aromas and elegance are the result.
